Please also to collect an application form from the office and return it to us as soon as possible, so that we can have a clear idea of numbers.

Hot lunches from AIP

Thank you to all of you who have activated your ParentPay accounts and are already choosing/paying for their child's food via ParentPay. Please ensure that you continue to order your child's lunches at least one week in advance and by midnight Wednesday each week, when the following week's menu will disappear. You need to do this even if your child is in years R - 2.

Please note that it is important that you select the main meal online but you can ignore the dessert, as your child will continue to have a selection of desserts to choose from each day. Therefore, we have asked ParentPay to remove the dessert choices when the next menu for next half term is uploaded.

Please may I urge you all to activate your ParentPay accounts now, even if you do not intend to order any hot lunches, as we will shortly start to use this facility for online payments generally, so as to make our school as cashless as possible. To help you with this, we will be reissuing the activation letters next week to those of you who have not yet made a start with this.

If you would like further information about ParentPay or would like help in activating your account, please pop into the school office next week on Monday (9th), Thursday (12th) or Friday (13th) between 10am and 11.00am and we will try to help you as best we can.

Special menu 19th January 2017

AIP is putting on a special menu on Thursday 19th January 2017 (of Roast Chicken or Cheese and Tomato Pizza) and we would like to encourage as many pupils as possible to partake of a hot meal on that day. Therefore, we are ordering a hot meal for every child in years R, 1 and 2 for that day only, even if you haven't selected one via ParentPay. For those whose parents have not selected a meal, we will be ordering the Cheese and Tomato Pizza option. Free School Meal eligibility

If you think you might be eligible for Free School Meals and you have a child in year R, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6, it is worth reading the attached form. It is a very easy and confidential check to make. Please speak to me in the office in confidence (at a quiet time) or send me an e-mail, if you would like more information. It is worth checking even if you are in receipt of Universal Free School meals in Key Stage 1, because your child will benefit in other ways for the next 6 school years if you qualify. Please don't wait until your child is in Key Stage 2 to check this out, if you think you may qualify.

Signing-in lists for children arriving late to school

From now on there is a signing-in sheet in the school office for you to complete, if your child is late to school on any day in the future. Please accompany your child to the office and sign them in, whilst our staff accompany the younger children down to class. Thank you in advance for this.
