#### Absence from school

Please remember to ALWAYS phone or e-mail <u>admin@overstone-wing.bucks.sch.uk</u> before 8.30am (and leave a message) if your child is going to be absent from school for that day.

#### Sickness or diarrhoea

If your child has sickness and/or diarrhoea, you must keep them off school for 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea, to avoid spreading germs to other children and staff.

## Last minute pick up arrangements

Please only call the office in cases of emergency on the afternoon concerned (eg. traffic hold-ups etc.). Pick up arrangements should be arranged well in advance and changes communicated to the classroom teacher in writing and in advance of the day concerned.

## Identifying yourself at the door

Please note that in order to keep your children safe, we ask you to identify yourself at the main door, when wishing to enter the building. We cannot see faces clearly from the office, particularly in the mornings, with the sun behind you. Many thanks for your understanding.



### **Head lice**

More nits have been reported again in year R, 4 and 5 – please take this opportunity to check your child's hair and treat thoroughly if necessary, following the manufacturer's guidelines. As well as the chemical products available for sale in most chemists, it is recommended to smother the hair in conditioner and comb through with a nit comb for several days, until all signs disappear. Some parents have reported that using tea-tree oil also helps, because the lice do not like the smell of it.
