Supporting your child

How do I find out what my child will be learning?

Full details of what your child will be doing at school can be found on the school website: www.overstone.eschools.co.uk.

In the section on Curriculum you will find:

- details of the reading and phonics scheme
- how maths is taught (calculation policy)
- what your child should learn at each age assessment without levels
- Curriculum plans that show what your child will learn each term
- Homework outlines for each stage of school.

Homework

Each week your child will have homework to share with you; this gives them an opportunity to show you what they have been learning. Allowing them to 'be the teacher' and explain an activity or process is one of the best ways of helping them to remember and practice what they have learnt in school.

How to help your child get the most out of their homework:

- Pick a good time to do the homework
- Allow your child to take the lead
- Read the notes on the sheet with your child
- Be positive—praise them to reinforce their learning.



Homework expectations change as your child progresses through the school. For details of the type of homework your child will receive please visit the school website.

Additional support (Pupil premium funding)

Children of low income families may be eligible for additional funding for their education as well as free school meals. This funding is paid to the school and is used to provide academic support to boost progress or as a means to enrich children's experiences in education.

Although all children in Key Stage 1 receive universal school meals your child may be eligible for this additional funding to support their education. It is therefore important to sign up for free school meals, even if your child is currently in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, so that the school receives all the funding it should for your child. If you would like to see if your child is eligible for Pupil premium please contact Mrs Edwardson.
