Office hours

Sickness or diarrhoea

If your child has sickness and/or diarrhoea, you must keep them off school for 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea, to avoid spreading germs to other children and staff.

Last minute pick up arrangements

Please only call the office in cases of emergency on the afternoon concerned (eg. traffic hold-ups etc.). Pick up arrangements should be arranged well in advance and changes communicated to the classroom teacher in writing and in advance of the day concerned.

All those going on the trip should have received your letters before half term, outlining the payment plan. The first instalment was due this week. Please would you pay it as soon as possible, if you have not already done so.
