#### **Swimming and Cryptosporidiosis**

It has been lovely seeing the children enjoy their swimming lessons this term. We are so very lucky to have such a facility at Overstone.

In line with Buckinghamshire County Council policy, please can everyone adhere to the following restrictions:

- If your child currently has, or has had diarrhoea in the past 48 hours, then they must not swim
- If your child has been diagnosed with, or you think they may have had cryptosporidiosis, then they must not swim for at least 14 days after the diarrhoea stops.

This policy refers specifically to preventing the spread of cryptosporidiosis. The main symptoms are watery diarrhoea with abdominal cramps, vomiting, fever and loss of appetite. Symptoms usually last 1-2 weeks but can last up to one month.

Cryptosporidium can contaminate water for several weeks after the symptoms have ended and immersion in the water may be sufficient for contamination to occur. We must therefore be very careful. I can assure you that our pool is regularly checked by experts. The water quality is good. However, we appreciate your co-operation by adhering to the above restrictions, in order to avoid an infection occurring.

# KS2 children

Please remember to send your child in with the correct equipment for KS2: pencil case including pens, pencils, ruler, glue stick etc. With decreasing budgets, we cannot keep supplying equipment to KS2.
