### Swimming

Swimming will begin next week, the children will need to bring with them a swim hat, a swimming costume or swim trunks (not shorts), crocs or flip flops and two towels. If children do not have the correct equipment they will not be able to swim.

### Forest School

Please ensure that your child comes to school equipped with the following: long sleeved tops and bottoms, waterproofs, wellies and hat and gloves. If the weather is particularly warm Mrs May does allow the children to wear short-sleeved t-shirts if the weather is very hot in the Spring/Summer.

### Everyday Essentials for the warmer weather

Please provide your child with a bottle of WATER to have in the classroom to drink through the day, as it is of great benefit to them. Many children are coming to school without water.

We hope that the weather will continue to warm up and in the event of this we ask that the children bring a sun hat to school with them, and have sun cream applied before they come to school in the morning. Children can bring their sun cream to school with them to re-apply through the day. Please ensure that the sun cream is clearly labelled.

Please can parents ensure that all items of clothing and equipment are LABELLED.
