### Whipsnade Visit

Please ensure your child comes in the appropriate clothing for the day - school uniform with jumpers/cardigans and a coat. If it is forecast to be cloudy please provide a sunhat for your child, as we will be outside for all of the day. Can you please ensure that you have applied sun cream to your child in the morning before going to school, as children will burn even on a cloudy day. We will be taking a large bottle of sun cream, hand gel and wet wipes around with each member of staff. If your child is allergic to any specific brand or you would not like them using the school's sun cream, then please notify us. Please make sure that your child has their lunch in a throwaway bag and that they have a named water bottle.

We hope that the lovely weather continues this term but we cannot stress enough the importance of the following items that your child requires on a **DAILY** basis:

A bottle of WATER

Sun hat and sun cream- it is best to apply this once before school and they can re-apply if necessary at lunchtime.
