This is art and D&T week at Overstone. The theme is around buildings and sculptures. Each class' learning will centre on this topic, with Maths and English being delivered through this area. The parents are invited into the school hall on Friday 15th March to look at what the children have been up to.

This week we will be:

- Learning about 2d and 3d shapes, then designing patterns and items using these

- Seeing what iconic structures there are in the UK
- Using nets to make a building from a traditional tale
- Playing a range of games in PE
- Following sequences in Dance

We have noticed an improvement in the children who access these games regularly in their schoolwork, either in their spellings or their calculations.
