What else will my child be learning about?

As always, the main topic areas are only a part of your child's learning.

We start science this year with Electricity, a very practical, hands-on part of the curriculum. Other science topics that will be covered this year are Light, Living Things and Habitats, Evolution and Animals (including Humans).

As ever, the use of the internet and online resources makes up a large part of the curriculum. It is important that children are taught about how to keep themselves safe online so our first area of learning in computing will cover this in detail. We will also look at computer networks, blogging and programming.

In Art and DT we will be learning about American artists and cookery around the world. In music we will cover notation, singing and the history of music.
