This week the Children have had a lot of fun exploring dinosaurs. We have made fossils, handprint dinosaurs and we have been writing about what dinosaurs like to eat. The Children have particularly enjoyed playing in the dinosaur island tuff spot and exploring the textures of the sand and soil. In maths we have been learning about patterns and Creating our own iCe Cream patterns. In Maths, we have made a zoo for our animals, sorting and counting them into their enclosures. The children have also enjoyed playing with a small world version of the story, creating stories of their own with the animals. Outside, Katherine has had lots of helpers to dig over the garden, to prepare it for bulbs being planted for the spring.
