Your support is very much appreciated and we would ask that all parents ensure that children come to school dressed appropriately

Pupils are expected to take pride in their uniform and appearance, creating a positive first impression of the school. Pupils are expected to take responsibility for their own appearance, upholding school uniform expectations and showing themselves to have the highest standards at all times.

If there are any doubts or queries with regard to our uniform policy, please contact us prior to purchasing new clothing/equipment etc. Order forms for uniform are available on our website and at the school office.

If you qualify for Pupil Premium funding or experience any difficulty with providing the uniform for your child, please contact the school directly. All enquiries are dealt with sympathetically and in the strictest confidence.

- ***long hair should be tied back at all times***
- ***no jewellery (except watches)***
- ***the wearing of earrings is considered inappropriate for school, however, if pupils have their ears pierced one PLAIN METAL STUD only may be worn in either ear lobe and must be removed for PE/Games and Swimming***
- ***Extreme hairstyles are not acceptable. Hairstyles should be of a consistent length with NO shaved sections/lines/patterns and/or distinct/sharp changes in length in the hair. Any changes in length should be graduated. Hairstyles should be no shorter than grade 2. Pupils whose hairstyle is not appropriate will be asked to modify that hairstyle***
- ***no tattoo transfers***
- ***no hair gel***
- ***no nail polish***
- ***children are expected to have their PE kit at all times***

**Mobile Phones/Tablets/interactive watches etc.**

- These items must be handed into the school office at the beginning of the day where they will be securely locked and returned at the end of the day. The school will not accept any responsibility for these items.

- A navy sweatshirt

We will provide a tabard for the younger children to wear each day.

**Please note:**

**PE and Games**

- Footwear black plimsolls (infant school)  
trainers (junior school)
- T shirt or polo shirt white
- Shorts navy blue
- Socks white/navy blue (no ankle/sports socks)
- Tracksuit top / Sweatshirt navy blue
- Tracksuit bottoms navy blue

**Swimming:**

- One piece swimming costume (not shorts or bikini)
- Flip flops/crocs/or equivalent for walking to and from the swimming pool
- 2 towels
- goggles – if permission slip has been returned.
